

Riptide Selected to Develop Exportable Training Capability-Instrumentation System

OVIEDO, FL – August 20, 2008 - Riptide Worldwide, Inc. (OTCBB:RTWW) (“Riptide”) announced today that its subsidiary, Riptide Software, Inc., has been selected by The U.S. Army Program Executive Office Simulation, Training and Instrumentation (PEO STRI) as a subcontractor to Inter-Coastal Electronics, Inc., to develop the Exportable Training Capability-Instrumentation System (ETC-IS).

The ETC-IS will be based at the National Training Center (NTC), Ft Irwin, CA and will provide transportable Instrumentation System connectivity at remote training sites (also known as Homestations) for Brigade Combat Teams (BCTs) in support of the Army Force Generation Model. Phase I of the program will deliver initial Army Battle Command Systems (ABCS), an Observer/Controller voice communications infrastructure, and the ability to provide training feedback to a training unit in an exportable configuration built from existing technologies and Commercial off the Shelf/Government off the Shelf (COTS/GOTS) to the NTC. Phase I will provide the capability to monitor, manipulate, and exploit command and control outputs of the battle command systems and voice networks for training feedback generation.

On this project, Riptide will provide subject matter expertise on the CTIA and LT2-related components and architecture for the operation of the ETC-IS. Riptide will work closely with the EXCON / AAR IPT in the development and integration of Live Training Transformation (LT2) components derived from the Homestation Instrumentation Training System (HITS) in the creation of the ETC-IS EXCON. Riptide will also assist with the integration of the Army Battle Command Systems (ABCS).

“ETC-IS is a critical next step in furthering the capabilities of the emerging LT2 Product line for PEO STRI.” said Barry Clinger, Chief Technology Officer of Riptide Software. “Riptide is proud to be providing the CTIA and LT2 capability for the winning ETC-IS team. ETC-IS will increase soldier training effectiveness that will ultimately save soldiers lives, as well as allow soldiers to train at Homestation and spend more time with their families before deployment.”
